The three leading—A.B.C.—Republics (Argentina, Brazil and Chile) accounted for \$92,481,067 or 66.3 per cent., of aggregate exports from the U.S.A., in 1928, and for \$136,379,734 or 70.8 per cent., in 1929, and for \$140,702,257 or 70.5 per cent. of total imports into the U.S.A. in 1928 and for \$165,035,608 or 73.9 per cent. in 1929. Exports from the United States to South America in 1929 show increase of \$53,322,707 or 39.0 per cent., and imports of \$23,604,113 or 11.8 per cent.

The trade of the United States with the ten South American Republics during the first quarter of the current year shows a net balance against exports in the aggregate of \$37,446,863, as compared with \$63,517,895 in 1928.

Argentina, Uruguay and other smaller South American Republics buy considerably more from the United States than they sell to that country, whilst Brazil, Chile, Colombia and Venezuela sell more than they buy.

Imports into the United States from Brazil alone exceeded exports to this country by \$34,728,746 or 77.6 per cent. in 1929 and by \$47,218,394 or 156.0 per cent. in 1928. In the case of Argentina, the position is the reverse, exports from the United States to that country exceeding

imports from that origin by \$28,001,955 or 61.2 per cent. in 1928.

In our issue of 15th inst. we showed the position of the United Kingdom and the United States in relation to the Brazilian overseas trade and the extent to which Brazil imports from and exports to those two countries. We pointed out, that exports from this country to the U.S.A. exceeded imports from that origin by 62.9 per cent. during the first quarter of the current year, whilst the interchange of trade with the United Kingdom during the same period last year shows an excess of imports into Brazil from that origin over exports to that destination of 503.7 per cent.

The United States, consequently, is by far Brazil's best customer, whilst the United Kingdom is the largest consumer of Argentine produce. The tables, therefore are reversed, allowing no margin for an argument in favour of British trade in Brazil. Lord D'Abernon's statement made in Buenos Aires yesterday (27th) to the effect that the tendency of trade in Great Britain was to "buy from countries which buy from us" applies solely, as a hint to the East Coast Republics of South America, to Argentina, for she sells more to Great Britain than she buys from her. This insinuation does not apply to Brazil, so far as the United Kingdom is concerned, for the simple reason that the position is the reverse. Even in the question of employment of capital, Great Britain has more to claim from Argentina than from Brazil.

We regret that the complete official returns of the foreign trade of the Republic of Argentina available are those up to 1927 only.

According to the "Revista de Economia Argentina" of July, 1929, the ratio of origin of to total Argentine imports and destination of exports per principal countries in 1927, is as follows:—

The above ratios support our conclusions with regard to the status of British and American trade in South America.

In 1927, Argentina exported 28.3 per cent. of the aggregate to the United Kingdom and only 8.2 per cent. to the United States and imported 19.4 per cent. and 25.4 per cent. respectively. In other words, exports from Argentina to the United Kingdom exceed imports from that origin by 8.9 per cent., whilst imports from the United States into Argentina exceed her exports by 17.2 per cent., in spite of the enormous amount of British capital employed in that Republic and of the fact that the United Kingdom is the largest consumer of Argentine produce.

Our inferences, consequently, are obvious!

In 1928, the United States imported 205,280 lbs. of raw cotton from Brazil, but nil in 1929. No cotton was exported from the U.S.A. to Brazil.

During the ten months ending April, 1929, (the fiscal year beginning July 1st), exports of wheat flour from the United States to Brazil amounted to 715,000 barrels, valued at \$4,307,000, as against 761,000 barrels, valued at \$5,184,000 during the same period in 1928.

Exports from the United States to Brazil during the first four months of the current year show increase of \$14,494,546 or 47.8 per cent., as compared with the same period last year, and imports from Brazil into the United States of \$2,004,898 or 2.5 per cent.; the balance against exports, consequently from the United States to Brazil declined by \$12,489,648 or 26.6 per cent.

### THE NEW BRITISH AMBASSADOR TO BRAZIL

A cable from Mexico City dated 24th inst. states that Sir Esmond Ovey, the newly appointed H.B.M. Ambassador to Brazil, sailed for this country via New York and London. Sir Esmond has been promoted from Minister at Mexico to Ambassador.

Sir Esmond Ovey, C.M.G., M.V.O., has had a distinguished career. He was made a C.M.G. in 1917 and M.V.O. in 1907; Councillor of Embassy, British Legation, Tehran, and temporarily employed at the Foreign Office. He was born on 23 July, 1879 and educated at Eton and abroad. Attaché, 1902; passed competitive examination, 1903; appointed to Tangier, 1904 (did not proceed); Stockholm, 1905; passed an examination in Public Law, 1905; granted an allowance for knowledge of Arabic, 1905; transferred to Paris, 1906; visited Moscow, Caucasus Mountains, and Crimea, 1900; Morocco, accompanying Diplomatic Mission to Fez, 1905; 2nd Secretary H.M. Diplomatic Service, Washington, 1908-15; also Florida, Cuba and Jamaica, and Minister at Mexico.

### THE BALANCE OF TRADE OF THE STATE OF ESPRITO SANTO

The little, but very progressive, State of Espirito Santo has nothing to learn from all the States of the Union, particularly its big sisters, who control the destinies of the country.

In proportion to its size, Espirito Santo contributes more towards the favourable balance of trade of Brazil than all the other States, its position being an enviable one.

According to official returns, the overseas trade of the State of Espirito Santo during the last five years shows considerable balances in favour of her exports, discriminated as follows:—

The apparent discrepancies in the balances in currency and sterling values are due to differences in exchange.

The foregoing returns show the trade position of Espirito Santo to be very prosperous, the tendency being for further and considerable improvement in view of the enormous strides the coffee production in the State has taken during the last two years. In five years time, that State will be exporting as much coffee, if not more, than the port of Rio de Janeiro, of cheaper and better quality. It is reported that Espirito Santo is already in a position to export 2,500,000 bags of coffee during the current crop and the fact that the port of Victoria exported 182,084 bags in July last alone, seems to confirm this statement.

### MORE AMERICAN CAPITAL FOR BRAZILIAN ENTERPRISE.

An advice from Maceio states that representatives of American capitalists are actually in that city studying the possibility of the purchase of the Alagoas Tramway, Light, Power, Telephone and Water Supply Services.

### ENTRY OF IMMIGRANTS AT THE PORT OF SANTOS.

During the first seven months of the current year 34,281 immigrants landed at the port of Santos. Altogether the State of São Paulo received 66,431 immigrants during that period, of which 34,281 landed at Santos and 32,150 arrived by rail.

### THE MANGANESE TRADE—WHAT OF BRAZIL?

A 'Reuters' advice from Moscow dated August 10 states that the United States Steel Corporation has offered to buy from the Gergian Manganese Trust from 80,000 to 150,000 tons of manganese per annum for the next five years.

Advices from Johannesburg (Cape), dated 11th ult., state that the Government has made port arrangements whereby a ship will call once a week to load manganese from Postmasburg. Space will be provided for sorting 10,000 tons free, and for another 40,000 tons at small cost.

In view of the suspension of the import duty on manganese in the United States, it would be interesting to know, in virtue of the above mentioned activities, what Brazil is doing to develop her erstwhile very prosperous industry? Brazilian trade returns for the five months en-

### CONVENTIONS FOR THE SIMPLIFICATION OF CUSTOMS FORMALITIES RATIFICATION BY BRAZIL

With reference to the notice in "The Board of Trade Journal" of 20th June (page 750), the Board of Trade announced on 1st inst. that the Convention for the Simplification of Customs Formalities, signed at Geneva on 3rd November, 1928, has been ratified by the Government of Brazil.

### BRITISH AND FOREIGN EXPORT TRADE PER CAPITA

Answering Brigadier-General Sir Henry Croft, in the House of Commons, says "The Board Trade Journal", Mr. W. Graham, President of the Board of Trade, presented the following statement showing, for the countries specified in the question, the value per head of the population of (a) the exports of domestic produce and manufactures and (b) the exports of such articles which were classed as wholly or partly manufactured:—

The value of new ships and boats exported in 1928 from the Irish Free State to places outside the British Isles was £15,618,000. Excluding this amount the values per head of the population were £13 18s. 1d. for total exports and £11 3s. 3d. for manufactured exports. Except in respect of this item, the figures cover throughout the same classes of manufactured goods. As the trade between Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Irish Free State is now included in the external trade of each of these countries, the necessary adjustments have been made to exclude the trade between them and so make the figures for 1928 comparable with those for 1880.

4. In the case of Germany, the figures for 1880 exclude, while those for 1928 include, the value of ships exported and also the value of the "Improvement Trade" for Home Account. The figures for 1928 represent a classification of goods differing in certain respects from that covered in 1880. The value of deliveries in kind on account of Reparations have been included in 1928. If Reparations in kind are excluded the values per head of the population in 1928 would be £8 16s. 2d. for total exports and £6 11s. 5d. for manufactured exports.

5. In the cases of France and of Germany the territories covered by the statistics for 1880 differ from those to which the figures for 1880 relate.

## BRAZILIAN TRACTIONS

On 6th July last, Brazilian Traction, Light & Power Company's shares were quoted in London at 59½, recovering on 24th inst. to 72¾, which is still below 84¾ of the early days of 1929. There was, of course, the increase in capital, when a distribution of one for every seven Old shares was made, but this in itself, we are told, would not have caused the setback. According to the "Financial News", there were many weak holders in Canada, and now that these have been weeded out, according to reports, a definite recovery may be anticipated.

Prospects of the Company are encouraging, the gross earnings having risen during the year by over \$1,500,000.

While conditions generally in Brazil, says "The Financial News", may not look too rosy, Traction is paying 88 a year in quarterly dividends, and could pay more on the actual profits made.

## BANCO NACIONAL ULTRAMARINO.

Advices from Lisbon dated 28th July, 1929, state that a decree published in the official journal outlines the new regime which is to be applied to banking in the Portuguese colonies.

The new regime is based on three points:— (1) The consolidation of the assets of the Banco Ultramarino. (2) The increase of the capital of the bank to 20,000,000 escudos, and (3) the simultaneous removal of the tax on fiduciary circulation and the gratuitous handing over to the bank of a block of liberated shares.

The colonial rate of exchange will be fixed by London and Lisbon.

The present authorised and issued capital of the Banco Nacional Ultramarino is Escudos 50,000,000.

## THE WORLD'S SHIPPING TONNAGE.

According to Lloyd's Register Book, the tonnage of the world in existence at June, 1929, of 100 tons and upwards, was 68,074,312 tons, of which 66,407,393 tons steamers and motorships and 1,666,919 tons sailing vessels.

The world tonnage in existence at June, 1929, and June, 1928, is discriminated as follows:—

The above tables show an increase in the world steam and motor tonnage in June, 1929, as compared with June, 1928, of 1,247,980 tons, but a shrinkage in the sailing vessel tonnage of 128,327 tons, leaving a net increase of 1,119,652 tons, as against a net increase in June, 1928, as compared with June, 1927, of 1,761,749 tons.

The countries showing largest increases are:— Germany, 315,301 tons; Great Britain and Ireland, 290,981 tons; Norway, 256,286 tons, etc. Only two of the principal maritime countries show appreciable decreases, viz: United States, 151,380 tons, and Italy, 144,157 tons, due, in both cases, to tonnage broken up since June, 1928.

Brazilian tonnage on 30 June last amounted to about 600,000 tons, being 13th on the list of world tonnage.

The increase in 1929, as compared with 1914, amounts to 21,004,000 tons, or 46.2 per cent., of which the United States accounted for 9,009,000 tons (sea going tonnage) or 44.444 per cent., Japan for 2,479,000 tons or 145.7 per cent., Italy for 1,785,000 tons or 124.8 per cent., France for 1,381,000 tons or 71.8 per cent., Holland for 1,460,000 tons or 99.1 per cent., Norway for 1,261,000 tons or 61.4 per cent., British Dominions for 1,163,000 tons or 71.3 per cent., Great Britain and Ireland for 1,154,000 tons or only 6.1 per cent., and other countries with smaller amounts. The net increase in tonnage owned abroad, in 1929, as compared with 1914 is 75.0 per cent., and that belonging to Great Britain and Ireland only 6.1 per cent. In spite of an increase of 1,548,000 tons since June, 1923, Germany is still short of her pre war tonnage to the extent of 1,077,000 tons or 20.9 per cent.

In 1914, Great Britain and Ireland accounted for 41.6 per cent. of the world's total tonnage, falling to 30.2 per cent. in 1929.

In 1914, there were 3,608 steamers and motor vessels of 4,000 tons and upwards in existence, this number rising to 6,335 in 1929, of which 425 are of 10,000 tons and upwards, including 59 of 20,000 tons each and above. Of the 425 vessels, 237 are under the British flag.

## COTTON IN THE UNITED STATES

A. Norden & Co's. Circular of August 9th, 1929.

The report issued by the Government yesterday, indicating a production of 15,543,000 bales, immediately created the impression among traders in general that there could be no scarcity of cotton in the event of this prospect being maintained. In consequence, it was felt that the trade would be prompted to confine price fixations to periods of weakness, and to postpone, as long as possible, the filling of their new crop requirements. This view, we think, is probably correct for, taking into consideration Colonel Hester's carry-over figures of 4,395,000, excluding linters, a total supply of approximately 200,000,000 bales is indicated whereas, on the other hand, there appear to be no strong reasons at present for expectations that, during the next twelve months, the world's consumption of American lint cotton will exceed 15,500,000 bales.

With regard to the details of the report, the tendency was to adopt the view that the Government had made a liberal allowance for probable loss due to weevil damage. This opinion is supported by the fact that the prospective yield per acre in Texas is placed at only 128 pounds against 138 last year and the ten-year average, 1918-1927, of 133. The absence of any official reference to drought conditions in parts of the western belt was regarded as signifying that private reports of excessive deterioration in the affected areas must, so far, have been exaggerated.

Sentiment has become so decidedly bearish that it is not surprising that attention is being drawn to the possibility of an early crop movement. The manner in which receipts will be absorbed remains to be seen, but the generally unfavorable condition of the world's cotton textile industry, the stringency in Europe, and the continued competition of Indian cotton are factors which cannot fail to have some effect on the demand.

The Crop Reporting Board points out that weevils are a real menace to the crop but that ultimate losses due to the insect will largely depend on weather conditions during the fruiting season. We feel that until the weather becomes so unfavorable as to create a revival of bullish confidence, the market will probably sag towards lower levels and, in our opinion, sales seem advisable on moderate rallies.

## REPORTS AND MEETINGS OF COMPANIES

### CITY OF S. PAULO IMPROVEMENTS AND FREEHOLD LAND COMPANY, LIMITED.

The seventeenth ordinary general meeting of the City of San Paulo Improvements and Freehold Land Co., Limited, was held, on the 26th ultimo, at River Plate House Finsbury Circus, London, Mr Herbert Guedalla, F. C. A. (the chairman), presiding.

The Secretary (Mr. F. S. Tomkins) having read the notice convening the meeting and the report of the auditors

The Chairman, in moving the adoption of the report and accounts, said that at the date of the balance sheet they had land in hand covering about 6,550,000 square metres, or about 1,635 acres, spread over ten estates within the Municipality of San Paulo. During the year they had sold altogether about 62 1/2 acres. The sales pertained to all their estates, and the area sold was very well spread. In value the sales for the year amounted to £371,000, as compared with £264,000 in the previous period, and the prices realised were, if anything, slightly better than those of the previous year.

On the sales for year they had realised about £96,000 above their balance-sheet valuation, which worked to about 43 per cent. above that valuation. There were certain

factors which had contributed to that remarkable increase in value, and he thought it might be more prudent to anticipate that at present selling prices their land was worth about 33 per cent. more than the balance-sheet valuation.

The company had earned the reputation of performing thorough and sound development work, and they had the advantage that they could finance the construction of houses and arrange public utilities for their estates. For that reason they had been approached by other estate owners with a view to purchasing their estates or coming to some arrangement with regard to management.

The net result for the year in San Paulo was a surplus of £240,135, and the total credit was £575,938. They had paid a dividend of 1s. per share, free of tax, and had a credit remaining of £445,149. They recognised that, with their business on such a flourishing basis, the shareholders were justly entitled to some sort of reward.

During the last six months it had become obvious to them that it was essential to conserve their cash resources as far as possible, but as far as he could see, within about eighteen months the actual cash receipts for instalments on land sold would be such that there should be no question as to their cash position or ability to make cash distributions.

They had consulted some of their larger shareholders with the result that the present scheme of distribution had been evolved. They had decided to recommend the shareholders to authorise an issue of 600,000 7 per cent. cumulative preference shares of £1 each, to be turned into preference stock at an early date, and at present they had no intention of issuing more than the £344,262 required for the proposed bonus.

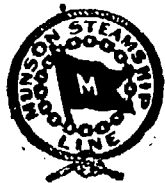
With regard to that preference issue, they must get away from the idea that they were a concern with a short life. It would probably take more than twelve years to realise their present property, and afterwards several years to collect the instalments.

They held a unique position in a great and progressive city, and in future years some decision would have to be arrived at as to the policy of continuing their enterprise on a more permanent basis. There was no reason, having regard to their position, why subject to normal fluctuations, there should not be at long era of prosperity before their undertaking.

Those preference shares, therefore, formed an excellent security, both from the point of view of capital and income, and shareholders might be assured that their position would be fully protected in the future when the time came to consider any further reduction in the ordinary capital of the company.

In proposing a bonus of 4s. per share they were making the distribution not only for the year under review, but for the current year, which took them up to February 28th next. It had been pointed out that, in making a share distribution, it would be better to make it as large as possible in order to ensure a freer market in the shares. After payment of that bonus, which they charged to their land sales account, they would be left with a surplus of about £100,000 on that account, but on the basis of the sales since the date of the balance sheet that surplus would be greatly increased by the end of the current financial year. They also had in hand the valuation reserve account, which was equivalent to about 50 per cent. of their ordinary share capital, and which constituted a very actual reserve.

The report and accounts were unanimously adopted, and resolutions were passed authorising the capitalisation of £344,262 8s. of the undivided profits and the distribution by way of bonus of 7 per cent. cumulative preference shares and increasing the capital of the company to £2,235,246 8s. by the creation of 600,000 preference shares of £1 each.

#### PARANA PLANTATIONS.

Report of Paraná Plantations for year 1928 states that as company has not yet received any income from its main investments in Brazil — its shareholdings in the Cia. de Terras Norte do Paraná and in the Cia. Ferroviária São Paulo-Paraná — a profit and loss account is not presented. At the date of balance-sheet company held 161,500 shares of 100 milreis each; additional shares have since been acquired, and your company now holds 175,000 shares out of 185,000 shares issued. As compared with year 1927, the balance-sheet of Cia. de Terras Norte do Paraná shows on the assets side further land acquired during the year east of the original property in anticipation of the railway's approach from that quarter, and on the liabilities side an increase in the issued share capital of 1,350 contos of shares, such shares having been issued to Paraná Plantations in satisfaction of certain advances made by them to Cia. de Terras Norte do Paraná towards purchase of additional land and for working capital. Surveys and the checking of surveys of properties of Cia. de Terras Norte do Paraná — amounting in all (subject to survey and after deduction of 10,000 alqueires, or, say, 60,000 acres, which Brazil Plantations Syndicate is entitled to select without payment) to approximately 3,030,000 acres of land — are not yet complete.

On part of the original block supposed to contain 350,000 alqueires (or, say, 2,100,000 acres), of which plans have been received from the surveyors, there appears to be a deficiency of area of between 2 per cent. and 3 per cent. The Paraná State Government is liable to make good to the Cia. de Terras Norte do Paraná out of other lands in its possession any shortage which surveys, when completed, may reveal in the company's original block as a whole. Survey and demarcation of the additional lands acquired in 1927 and 1928 east of the original block, amounting in all to approximately 65,000 alqueires (or, say, 390,000 acres), is proceeding, but is not yet complete.

The railway company, having acquired the necessary land, is actively engaged upon the organisation of its headquarters at Ourinhos, upon reconditioning the existing 29 kilometres of track and upon acquisition of new rolling stock. Plans for first 29 kilometres of new construction were approved in April by the Paraná State Government, and construction began in May of the current year. The railway company aims at completing the line to the Tibagy river (that is, to within a few kilometres of the eastern boundary of the lands of the Cia de Terras Norte do Paraná) by 31st Dec. 1931.

#### BRAZIL PLANTATIONS.

Reports of Brazil Plantations Syndicate for year 1928 states that provision has been made for bad debts, but in this period of realisation of assets it is considered unnecessary to make provision for depreciation of buildings, fixed plant and machinery. Profit and loss account shows loss for year of £ 3,707, which, added to balance brought forward, makes a total loss of £ 28,548 to be carried forward. In pursuance of policy announced in last report, the company's efforts have been devoted to the realisation of its Brazilian properties. The selling price, less expenses, has been deducted from the figure at which the assets stood in company's books. Average value of balance of land unsold as at 1st Jan., 1929, is not below that of land sold before that date, and if in the realisation of this balance the progress of sales and the selling prices obtained in 1928 are maintained, the surplus arising therefrom will more than cover the present adverse balance of the profit and loss account. If the prices obtained to date for sales effected during the present year are maintained, such surplus should suffice to cover in addition the estimated eventual loss on realisation of ginnetries, sawmills and brickworks. Company would then remain with its right to select 10,000 alqueires (or approximately 60,000 acres) in North Paraná, for which no credit has been taken in the accounts.

Company holds 10,000 shares out of a total issued capital of 185,000 shares of the Cia. de Terras Norte do Paraná, which, subject to certain payments to the Paraná Government, owns approximately 3,000,000 acres of land. Since the abandonment by company of cotton growing its activities and interests and those of Paraná Plantations are in the main similar, and directors, five of whom are also directors of Paraná Plantations, have for some time had under consideration the amalgamation of the two companies. The main assets of Paraná Plantations are shares in the Companhia de Terras Norte do Paraná, shares in the São Paulo-Paraná Railway Company (Companhia Ferroviária São Paulo-Paraná) and cash. The main assets of Brazil Plantations Syndicate, apart from such of its properties as are now in process of realisation, and apart from its cash and periodical receipts from land sales, are its shares in the Companhia de Terras Norte do Paraná and its right to select land from the properties of that company. To both Brazil Plantations Syndicate and Paraná Plantations therefore the extension of the São Paulo-Paraná Railway so as to provide the lands of the Companhia de Terras Norte do Paraná with communications is of prime importance.

The directors of Paraná Plantations, subject to their shareholders' approval, have now decided to make an offer to the shareholders of the Brazil Syndicate to purchase their shares by way of exchange, at par, for shares in Paraná Plantations, provided that the holders of 90 per cent. accept such offer. Respective market prices of the shares of the two companies are nearly the same. A meeting of shareholders of Paraná Plantations will be held on 7th Aug., and if at that meeting the above offer is authorised the shareholders of the Brazil Company will be advised thereof by circular as soon as possible thereafter.

The exchanged market continues lifeless, both takers and sellers continuing to be conspicuous by their absence, the rates in all banks closing this afternoon unchanged from last Wednesday's close.

The market, as we stated in our last issue, is well under the judicious control of the Bank of Brazil and, consequently, no change can be expected at this juncture, in spite of the disturbances in London & New York. For no apparent reason and much against general expectations, the Federal Reserve Bank rate in New York was raised on 9th inst. from 5 to 6 per cent., which came as a bomb-shell to all markets. As the New York and London markets were not prepared for the change, its effect was pronounced. An official statement was issued on 9th that in the opinion of the Bank of England the raising of the Federal Reserve discount rate did not necessarily imply a consequent rise in the Bank of England rate. The action of the Federal Reserve Board puzzled banking circles generally.

**Transit Passengers** calling at Santos usually have ample time to ascend the slopes of the forest-clad mountain range known as the «Serra do Mar»; special trains will, at an hour's notice, be placed at their disposal at a cost of 200 milreis for 40 passengers, plus Govern ment impost of 1\$800 per passenger travelling. Above that number 7\$500 each person.

The return trip lasts 3 hours in all, giving time for lunch at the top of the Serra («Alto da Serra»).

Passengers arriving early at Santos can also usually visit the city of São São Paulo; leaving Santos by the 8.19 train, they reach São Paulo at 10.20. After a motor drive through this large city with over 1000,000 inhabitants, the 12.15 train will land them in Santos at 14.40 in good time to catch the steamer sailing at 15.30 or later.

The São Paulo Railway, whose first section began in 1860, has been assiduously consolidated and improved since then, and has long enjoyed a deserved reputation as second to none in the world in point of solidity and security.

The inclined Planes on the Serra represent a triumph of engineering science and perseverance. The geological characteristics of the ground are such as to render construction and maintenance of railway lines over it a work demanding the utmost patience, skill and care.

**São Paulo** sometimes called the «Chicago of South America» and whose prosperity bids fair at no distant date to rival that of its above named American contemporary — is a bright breezy city, situated on a tableland 2,700 feet above sea-level, and distant 79 kilometres, or, 1h. 50ms. by São Paulo Railway from Santos. The sanitation is perfect and the climate bland.
