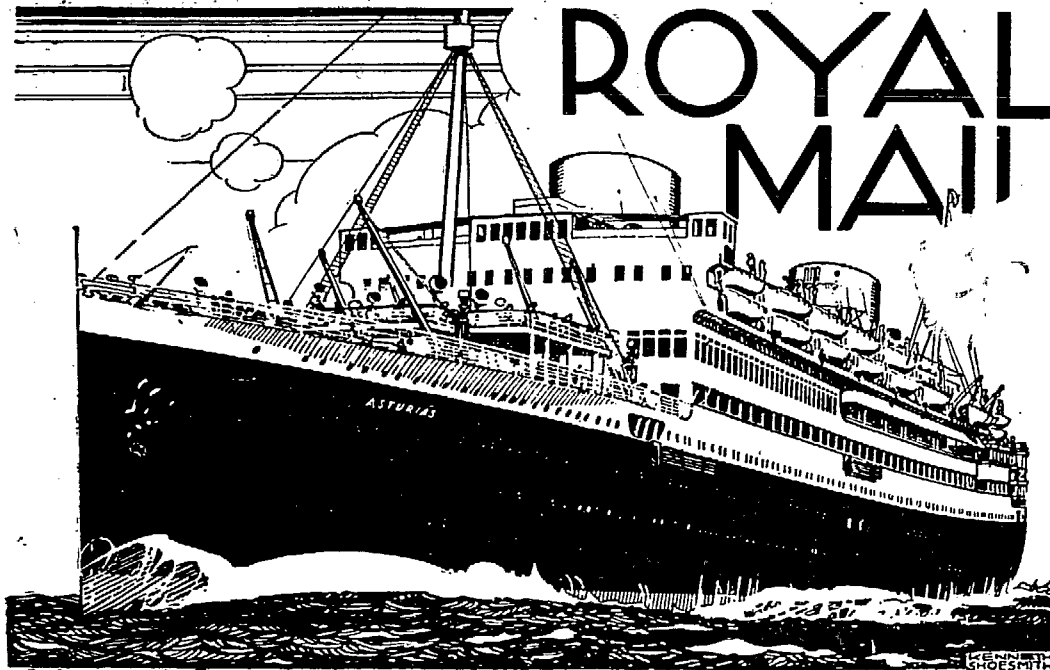

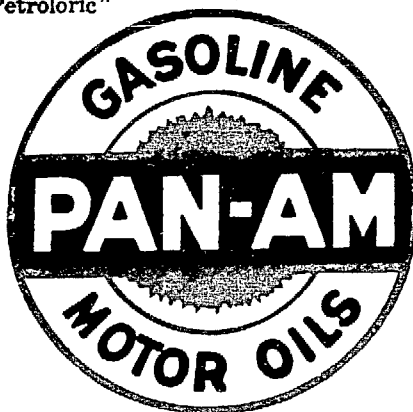

LONDON FINANCIAL POSITION

14th December, 1934

The Chancellor of the Exchequer has stated that cheap money is still an essential part of the Government's policy. This explicit pronouncement had some influence upon the discount market, for presumably it means that if necessary the authorities will take measures to check any hardening tendency of rates. It also helped gilt-edged securities, which developed fresh buoyancy this week, though general business on the Stock Exchange is showing the tendency to diminish that is usual at the approach of Christmas and the end of the year. Still, there is underlying firmness, especially as the feeling regarding European politics has improved so much since the agreement between France and Germany regarding the Saar territory. Apprehension of possible serious trouble between Yugoslavia and Hungary consequent upon the wholesale expulsion of Hungarians from the former country has now died away, an amicable settlement having been reached at Geneva. There is still considerable activity in new capital issues, many of which are for conversion purposes. The latter include a £11,000,000 South African Government loan in 3 per cent stock offered at par. The proceeds are to pay off the outstanding balance of the Transvaal Government 3 per cent loan (a relic of the last Boer war) the principal and interest of which are guaranteed by the Imperial Government. It is partly in order to get rid of this guarantee, which is no longer necessary, that the old 3 per cent loan will be paid off. The South African Government will be paying the same rate of interest but will save something, be-



Our trade figures for November are quite satisfactory, for although the period contained one working day less than October last the exports show a reduction of only £623,500 compared with those of the latter month which were the highest for nearly four years. British manufactures are well maintained, and for the first eleven months of this year the total is £279,187,000 an increase of fully £20,000,000 compared with the corresponding period of 1933. It is regrettable that there are still hindrances to world trade recovery. Italy has lately issued a decree which is directed towards a mobilisation of its foreign credits. Banks, companies, and corporations of every kind in the country are required to offer their credits abroad to an Institute for Foreign Exchange and if necessary to sell them to that Institute for lire at the current exchange rate in the case of liquid or sight assets, while Italian citizens are required to make a return of their financial interests in foreign countries. This somewhat retrograde step by Italy has been adopted for the purpose of keeping the lira linked with gold, for during this year there has been a substantial drop in the gold reserve of the Bank of Italy. Evidently the regulations have been modified somewhat, for it is announced that branches in Italy of foreign banks have been granted permission to resume dealings in foreign currency.

The deputy Chairman of the Bank of London and South America referred to the Brazilian exchange question, showing the different rates for the milreis that are now in operation, and pointing out that the trading interests of certain countries

are prejudiced by the fact that exchange is allotted at the official rate by the Banco do Brasil to foreign countries according to the amount of coffee purchased by the latter. It is considered that while such restrictions are enforced world recovery will be retarded. The deputy chairman of the Bank of London and South America also referred to the great increase during the last year or two in the cotton exports from Brazil. Brazilian Government bonds rallied sharply on the denial by the Brazilian Ambassador here of a recent report that the Government may not maintain the debt service on the terms laid down by the plan formulated in February last. The railway stocks are still an unsatisfactory market, and there has been virtually no improvement in Argentine RAILS, though the market for Cordoba Central 1½ per cent Debenture has shown a certain amount of liveliness, presumably on the possibility of Government acquisition of the system.

Discussion of the report on Indian Constitutional Reform proceeded smoothly and the acceptance of the provisions by the House of Commons was followed by a sharp rise in Indian Government stocks. Annual reports of industrial companies are still showing up well, and in most cases increased profits are disclosed. The Smithfield and Argentine Meat Company has declared a dividend of 2½ per cent on its Ordinary capital — the first since 1920. A Welsh colliery merger has been provisionally arranged which will involve about £17,000,000 of capital and will include 75 collieries one of the signs that every advantage is being

taken of the revival in internal trade. Retail business here is also improving, and in connection with the increased expenditure anticipated at Xmas the last three returns of the Bank of England show a total expansion in the note circulation of £16,316,000, or nearly £2,000,000, more than in the corresponding period of 1933. The movement has brought the note circulation to £393,221,000, the highest amount since the Treasury notes and Bank of England notes were amalgamated. These figures indicate an expectation by the banks of an increased demand for currency by the public for Xmas expenditure.

The November statement of the ten London Clearing banks shows that last month those institutions increased their holdings of investments by nearly £14,000,000 to the record high total of £589,000,000. It is calculated that in the last 2½ years (which marks the duration of the present 2 per cent Bank Rate) the amount of banking resources that has gone into the gilt-edged market, including purchases of securities by means of overdrafts, is about £300,000,000. These holdings will be reduced ultimately and prices will decline, but this will only be when we have a bigger world trade and the resumption of foreign lending of which there is little indication yet. The banks are forced to increase their holdings of long-term investments because of the unremunerative rates obtained from discounting bills and form loans to the Money Market. Ordinary banking profits have probably diminished this year, but there is no expectation of a cut in dividends, partly because of a smaller neces-

sity for providing for bad and doubtful debts, while the position has been improved somewhat by the repayment of loans that previously had been frozen for a very long period. It is also possible that although the banks have increased their investments, changes in the holdings have led to some augmentation of profits.

LONDON PRODUCE NOTES

14th Dec. 1934

SUGAR It has been a very quiet week on the London Produce Markets, with price movements generally small and unimportant. Business in raw sugars has been confined to a few small parcels of foreign 96% at prices from 4/3 to 1/3 ¾d. per cwt. according to position. Even so, buyers display very little interest at the moment, but on the other hand, sellers show no disposition to press sales, and still ask 1/3 ¾d. for near shipment. The futures market has been lifeless and not much change is expected until the New Year. Refined kinds were also in slow demand but no alteration has been made in prices. The statistical position shows some improvement over last year, the world's visible supplies being estimated at 6,429,000 against 7,062,000 tons at this period of 1933. It has been proposed that Java should not plant any cane in 1935 for the 1936 crop, but no final decision has yet been made, while for the coming season the output is estimated at about 460,000 tons, against 1,313,660 for last year. Shipments from Java

so far this season total 761,000 tons, and the stock in Java is now returned at 2,300,000 tons against 3,000,000 tons last year. The eventual absorption of this huge stock would go a long way to make for better conditions in the industry generally.

RUBBER — The rubber market has been dull throughout the week with a decline to 6 3/16d. per lb. for smoked sheet spot. The Government of the Dutch East Indies has reduced the export tax on native rubber to 16 per cents per kilogram, for it was found that the previous duty of 20 cents had brought about a too large reduction in supplies, with the result that shipments have fallen below the quota allotted under the restriction scheme.

COCOA — There has been a further improvement in cocoa prices, although there was some reaction finally. Good fermented Acera, Jan/Mar. shipment, sold up to 21/6 per 50 kilos, c. i. f. Continent, while for Lagos, f. a. q. sellers were asking 21/3. Reports from the Gold Coast indicate that while there is no organised hold up of sup-

plies, there is a disinclination to sell more than necessity compels.

TEA — There was some weakness in both Indian and Ceylon teas at this week's auctions. Prices of common sorts were fully farthing per lb. lower, while medium kinds showed declines up to halfpenny per lb. Exceptionally fine teas were firm, and in the case of the choicest Ceylon qualities, the prices realised were sometimes as much as 3d. per lb. over valuation. Next week's auctions have been postponed until after the Christmas and New Year holidays, so that no further tea sales will be held until 7th January.

The market for raw jute opened dull, with only a small business passing at down to £16.5.0 for first marks, Dec. Jan. shipment. Sellers, however became very reserved at the lower levels and with some speculative interest in evidence at the close, especially for forward positions, prices rallied 5 - to 7.6 per ton.

TIMBER — Fair demand for Lagos and Honduras mahogany and moderate inquiry for Benin but prospects for other varieties not promising. Cargo quotations: Tabasco, squared 7d. to 10d., round 5d. to 8d.; Guatemalan 6d. to 9d.; Honduras, squared 9d. to 11d., round 6d. to 9d. Nicaraguan squared 7d. to 9d., round 6d. to 8d.; Costa Rican 5d. to 8d.; Panama 5d. to 8d.; Colombian 5d. to 6d.; Axim, Grand Bassam, & c. 1d. to 5d.; Lagos, Benin, Niger 1¹/₂d. to 6¹/₂d.; Cape Lopez, 3d. to 1d.; Gaboon, squared 2³/₄d. to 3³/₄d., round 2d. to 2¹/₂d.; Cuba 1d. to 8d.; St. Domingo and Jamaican 1d. to 8d. per foot.

FRUIT — Arrivals of oranges from Brazil and South Africa were shorter, but this was offset by imports from Spain, which made the demand slow and led to lower prices. Denia and Valencia 240's, 10s. to 28s.; Almeria 240's, 18s. to 26s.; Murcia 240's 11s. 9d. to 13s. 6d.; Cyprus 8s. 6d. to 9s. 6d. South African 10s. to 13s., and Brazilian 12s. 6d. to 18s. per box Bananas had a fair trade with Canary quoted 11s. to 11s. per crate; Jamaica 7d. to 9d., and Brazilian 6d. to 8d. per dozen. Grapefruit was cheaper; Jaffa 10s. 6d. to 12s. 6d.; Florida 10s. to 21s. per box. Imports from Brazil last week 31,000 bunches of bananas and 11,000 boxes of oranges.

HIDES — Trading was moderately active with B. A. Americanos on the basis of 5 11 16d.; B. A. Becerros 6¹/₂d.; B. A. Anchos and Cuyabanos at 1¹/₂d., and Chubuts at 5³/₄d. In Brazil there was business in salted Barretos at 3⁵/₄d. and dry Santa Catharina at 5³/₄d. per lb. Mombasas sold at 4³/₄d. to 1¹/₂d., and unbathed Adis Abedas at 5³/₄d. for 8 12 lb.
