RIVER PLATE ITEMS.
 —The Argentine government has granted a railway concession from Paraná to the Brazilian frontier to Messrs. Garrido & Co. A grant of thirty leagues of land goes with the concession.
 —Telegrams from Buenos Aires last week state that enormous clouds of locusts are threatening the cultivated districts. The government has appropriated \$300,000 for the destruction of the insects.
 —The September receipts of the Montevideo custom-house were \$722,941.92, which are below those for September of the three preceding years, but are an improvement on those of the five preceding months.
 —Mr. C. Akers, special correspondent of the London Times, who has been some five months in the River Plate, left for the West Coast on Saturday. He will remain in that part of the world about a year, visiting Chile, Perú, Bolivia, and some of the Central American republics.—*Montevideo Times.*
 —The department of public gardens has not been idle during the winter. About 16,000 trees were planted along avenues and in plazas and more than 85,000 in Palermo park. It has, besides, given a great number of plants to hospitals and public institutions, amounting in all to more than 111,000 trees and shrubs.—*Buenos Aires Herald.*
 —During the month the estimates for 1898 of the municipality of Buenos Aires have been presented to the council. They run up to something like 20,000,000 currency, or say a million and a half sterling, which is not at all bad for a city of 700,000 inhabitants, which does not own or run the usual public services for its own account.—*St. Andrew's Gazette.*
 —The Uspallata Pass over the Andes is reported to be in good condition now for carriages as far as Juncael, and from thence by mules and horses. It is difficult to keep the pass in good order as the winds fill it up, there being at present some thirty men employed to keep it in order, of which over a third are cutting through snow.—*Times, Buenos Aires.*
 —The Rosario branch of the London and River Plate Bank has been robbed of \$147,000 by its sub-cashier, Frederick Shaw, who has been taking out money for the last three years and concealing it by means of false cheques, and concealing it by means of false cheques, and entries and balances. He says he took the money to loan to his brother, Herbert Shaw, who was always asking him for money. Fearing detection, he finally confessed to his father, who at once advised the manager. Both brothers are under arrest.
 —Feeling towards the United States on the part of Argentines has not been of the most cordial, for it is felt that the Dingley tariff with its burdens upon hides and wool, is an unworthy return for the attempt which Argentines made to offer large profits and quick returns to the North American republic. Our finance minister, with the hearty support of our amateur economists, will probably place taxes upon North American produce, for the sake of proving, even at a sacrifice, that he believes in reciprocity.—*St. Andrew's Gazette.*
 —Professor Brunner is in Paraguay. He proposes to take a trip across the Paraguayan Chaco to Bolivia, conditions permitting, with the idea of noting whether the locusts have any particular breeding ground in that direction, as is asserted. The journey will take three months. Mr. Oliver C. James' estancia at Caracará is still his head quarters for experimenting with caged locusts and cultivating locust diseases. They have caged there a new gigantic species sent from La Rioja, where it has appeared in small numbers. It is of a lead colour and double the size of the ordinary insect. Professor Brunner is of opinion that the flying locusts should be caged, and that the means adopted by the committee are excellent.—*Review, Buenos Aires.*
 —It is really time that some little change were made in regard to the nominal session in Congress. Our legislators are supposed to work from May to September. Anything after that is a sort of legislative overtime, if we may use so ordinary a word in connection with so exalted a body. But as a matter of practice, it is very seldom indeed that anything is done in May, and as for the session closing at the end of September, that is merely an expression. Practically, all the important work of the session is done after the official session is closed. Dr. Escalante had promised to set an example for all future finance ministers to follow, but his budget was sent to committee at about the usual time. The session ends, and the budget has still to be submitted to the house. Then our legislators warm to their work as the weather warms, and the finishing touches are given to tariff and estimates in the blazing heat of the end of December, when commerce waits to see what will be done, and legislators have but one thought, that of getting the business disposed of. It is all very absurd. If the session is not long enough, let it be extended: if it is long enough, let the work be despatched, instead of dragging on.—*Review, Buenos Aires.*
 —Count Teikichi Tamaka, the Japanese commercial envoy who has been staying in Buenos Aires for a few days and left on Saturday for Chili, has stated that a line of steamers will be established between Japan and South American ports in June next year. A company has been formed with Japanese capital amounting to three millions sterling. The vessels will take two routes, one across the Pacific to Perú, Chili, and round the Cape to this port. The other route is via Suez, London, Rio and Buenos Aires. Count Tamaka will stay for a short time in Valparaiso and then will proceed to Perú, Bolivia, Venezuela and Panamá.—*Montevideo Times, October 5th.*

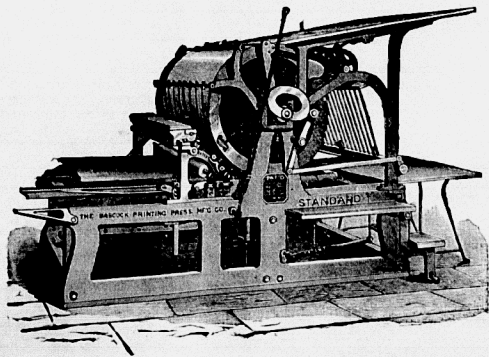

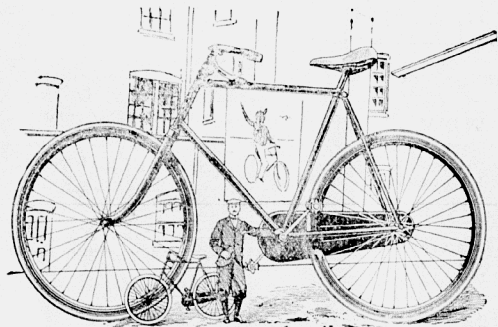
